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### **NOTES TO THE APPROVAL**

1. Quote if the system of replacing with or without previous import shall be applied.
2. Description must be detailed, it should enable customs authorities supervision over the flow of procedure.
3. Expected norm should be entered, that is, quote the method for determining it.
4. Quote all means for goods' identification.

The customs authority can use the following methods:

- (a) quoting or description of special marks or production numbers of temporary exported goods;
  - (b) affixing customs leads, seals or other recognition marks;
  - (c) taking samples, submitting pictures or technical descriptions of goods;
  - (d) comparative analysis of exported and re-imported goods.
