1. Certificate on trade of goods EUR. 1 shall be completed in the forms of certificate for trade of goods EUR. 1, and the application for certificate on trade, the copies of which have been enclosed. The forms shall be completed in local, English or French language, according to the provisions of the domestic law in the territory or of exporting state. If they have been entered by hand, they must be completed using a fountain pen and in printed letters. The products must be described in envisaged boxes without empty lines. If the box has not been completed in full, it is necessary to draw, below the last row, a horizontal line and to cross the empty space below.

2. Each form is of size 210 ×297 mm; tolerance is minus 5 mm or plus 8 mm. One should use white, wood-free writing paper with the minimum weight of 25 g per square meter. The back shall be printed in green layout "guilloche", so any forgery with mechanical or chemical means can be easily noticed

3. The authorities in charge in the territory or in the export state can retain the right to print them themselves, or to order their printing from authorized organizations. In the latter case, each form must refer to such authorization. On each formthe name and address of the printing house, or a mark enabling its identification must be quoted. The form must have a serial number, printed or not, enabling its identification.

Notes:

1. In the certificate nothing can be deleted or added. Possible corrections must be executed in such a way as to strike through the incorrect quotations and if necessary, add the correct ones. Each such change must be confirmed by a person completing the certificate and certified by the customs authority of the state issuing the certificate.

2. The products quoted in the certificate must be enumerated without interruption and in front of each product ordinal number must be stated. Directly below the last product a horizontal line must be underlined. Unused space must be crossed in such a way that later addition is impossible.

3. Goods must be described according to the trade usages, so that it can be identified.
