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NOTES TO INDIVIDUAL APPLICATION BOXES

AD 1. Box 1(a) shall not be completed if the application shall be submitted on paper which in its letterhead already contains all necessary data. Box 1(b) shall be completed when the approval holder and manufacturer are not the same person.

AD 2. In column (a) must be sufficiently accurate description, as to enable the customs authorities passing decision about the application, especially regarding meeting economic conditions.

In column (b) should be sufficient 4-figure tariff number, if the 10-figure tariff mark is not necessary for proper procedure performance.

In the column (c) one should quote the quantity in measuring units (kilograms, liters, meters ...). It can be quoted for the planned import period.

Box (d) shall be completed in such a way as to quote the customs value, which can be calculated based on data from the enclosed documents.

AD 3. Boxes (a) and (b) should be completed according to the rules for boxes 2(a) and 2(b).

AD 4. One should enter the expected norm for resulting products, that is, to show the way for its determining.

AD 5. One should present which operations shall be performed on the imported goods, in order to make processed products. One should take into consideration supplement 23 to this Ordinance.

AD 6. Exact address of the place where production operations shall be performed should be entered.

AD 7. Average time necessary for performing production operation and time that passes till the end of procedure shall be entered.

AD 8. The most appropriate method for recognizing imported goods in processed products shall be entered.

AD 9. The customs authority in charge shall be entered in column (a) for performing supervision over the complete procedure, in column (b) for acceptance of declaration during intake of goods and in box (c) the authority approving procedure or use approved by customs, at the end of the procedure.

AD 10. Period shall be quoted in which goods shall be imported for processing.

AD 11. The applicant can within this point quote the data he deems relevant.
