## ANNEX 48 LIST OF ORDINARY FORMS FROM ARTICLE 327 OF THE DECISION

Should it not be determined otherwise, none of the following procedures can result in different eight digit marks.

Ordinary forms of handling listed in the following text shall not be permitted when, in opinion of customs bodies, this action could increase the risk of fraud:

- 1. Ventilation, stretching, drying, removal of dust, simple cleaning actions, repair of packages, elementary repairs of damages occurred during transport or storing while this pertains only to simple actions, placement and removal of protective transport layer.
- 2. Reconstruction of goods after transport.
- 3. Inventory, sampling, sorting, sifting, mechanical filtering, weighing of goods.
- 4. Removal of damaged or infected components.
- 5. Conservation through pasteurisation, sterilisation, radiation or by adding preservatives.
- 6. Protection against parasites.
- 7. Protection against rust.
- 8. Protection:
  - by simple elevating the temperature without further treatment or distilling process;
    - simple lowering the temperature

even when it results in a change of the eight-digit tariff mark.

- 9. Electronic protection, straightening or ironing of textile.
- 10. The protection consists of:
  - removal of petioles and/or seeds of fruit, cutting and breaking dried fruit or vegetables, rehydration of fruit or;
  - dehydration of fruit even when it results in change of eight-digit tariff mark;
- 11. Desalinisation, cleaning and joining raw leathers.
- 12. Additives to goods or adding or replacement of additional components until those components or replacements are relatively limited or intended to provide fitting into technical standards and it does not change character or improve effects of the original goods, even if it results in change of eight-digit tariff mark for additional or replaced goods.
- 13. Diluting or concentrating of liquid without further process of treatment or distilling, even if it results in a change of the eight-digit tariff mark.

- 14. Mixing all types of goods, of various quality in order to achieve evened quality or quality requested by the purchaser, without changing the character of the goods.
- 15. Dividing or cutting of goods, when only simple actions are included.
- 16. Packing, unpacking, change of packaging, re-pouring or simple placement and re-placement in the boxes, even if it results in a change of the eight-digit tariff mark, pinning, removal or change of marks, seals, labels, stickers with price or other similar signs of distinction.
- 17. Testing, tuning, regulating, starting the work of the machines, apparatuses and vehicles, particularly for the purpose of control of technical standards if pertaining only to simple actions.
- 18. Adjustment of the profile of the pipes in order to prepare the goods for certain markets.
